

# What is the UDS Mapper?

- ▶ An online mapping tool developed by the AAFP's Robert Graham Center, as part of the *HealthLandscape* mapping platform
- ▶ Developed for the Bureau of Primary Health Care using UDS data analyzed and prepared by John Snow, Inc. (JSI) and other relevant data to provide access to maps, data and analysis to visualize service area information for Health Center Program (HCP) grantees and look-alikes
- ▶ Compares HCP grantee and look-alike data to community/population data and shows spatial relationships between the program, community attributes and other resources

# Who Can Use the UDS Mapper?

- ▶ The UDS Mapper is open to everyone, not just Health Center Program grantees and look-alikes
- ▶ To begin using the UDS Mapper all you have to do is register for a username and password at [www.udsmapper.org](http://www.udsmapper.org)
- ▶ More than one person from an organization CAN have a login for the UDS Mapper

# Data in the UDS Mapper

- ▶ Data mapped by ZCTA
  - ▶ Uniform Data System (UDS) data, 2012
    - ▶ UDS Data submitted to HRSA by Health Center Program grantees and look-alikes every calendar year
    - ▶ Data analyzed and prepared by John Snow, Inc.
  - ▶ 2010 US Census boundaries for ZCTAs
- ▶ What is a ZCTA?
  - ▶ ZIP Code Tabulation Area- an approximation of ZIP Codes from the US Census Bureau

# Data in the UDS Mapper

- ▶ Calculated layers
  - ▶ Penetration of low-income and total populations
  - ▶ ZCTA-level low-income population not served by HCP grantees (2 layers)
  - ▶ Change in patients over time (for grantees)
- ▶ Demographic layers (2007-2011 American Community Survey)
  - ▶ Percent poverty
  - ▶ Percent low-income
  - ▶ Percent non-white
  - ▶ Percent Hispanic
  - ▶ Percent Black
  - ▶ Percent Asian
  - ▶ Percent American Indian/ Alaska Native

# Data in the UDS Mapper

- ▶ Other data in the UDS Mapper
  - ▶ Point location of health care providers
    - ▶ Health Center Program (HCP) Grantees and Look-Alikes
    - ▶ HCP Grantee and Look-Alike Service Access Points
    - ▶ Rural Health Clinics
    - ▶ National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Sites
    - ▶ Facility and Point HPSAs (CHCs, HCP-LAs, RHCs, and tribal organization facilities)
    - ▶ Hospitals
  - ▶ Medically Underserved Areas/ Populations
  - ▶ Health Professional Shortage Areas (Primary Care)
  - ▶ Geographic boundaries including census tracts, congressional districts, etc.
  - ▶ Highways
  - ▶ Background options include satellite imagery, topographical maps, and street maps

# Data Considerations

- ▶ UDS Data
  - ▶ Health Center Program grantees and look-alikes only
  - ▶ ZCTA only
  - ▶ If there are 10 or fewer patients from a health center in a ZCTA, those data are suppressed
  - ▶ Low-income calculations are based on 100% of patients
- ▶ ZCTAs
  - ▶ Changing/evolving ZIP Code boundaries

# Walkthrough of UDS Mapper

## How to use the UDS Mapper tool to:

- ▶ begin exploring and comparing nearby areas for a new location
- ▶ compare these areas with ZCTAs that have existing services
- ▶ inspire additional questions and hone subsequent, more in-depth analyses performed outside of the UDS Mapper




## ▶ Zooming




- ▶ Scale tool
  - ▶ Click on the plus (+) sign at the top or minus (-) sign at the bottom
  - ▶ Click on the line representing the scale you want to go to
  - ▶ Click and drag the selector up and down the scale tool
- ▶ Double click twice on the map
- ▶ Use your mouse wheel if you have one
- ▶ Click on a nub




## ▶ Panning



- ▶ Click and hold the mouse button while on the map to drag/ pan the map until you have it where you want it



Health Care Facilities can be found in the Explore Service Area Tool. These all have rollovers that can be turned on and off.







# Selecting ZCTAs for Analysis

- ▶ Click on map- click once on a ZCTA to select/ unselect a ZCTA
  - ▶ ZCTAs can only be selected at a scale of "County" or less (8<sup>th</sup> line down on scale bar or higher)
- ▶ Use Explore Service Area tool
  - ▶ Enter ZCTA or ZIP Code and add directly
  - ▶ Enter County or State to zoom to area and then click on map to select ZCTAs
  - ▶ Use paint brush to select all ZCTAs you cross with your mouse
  - ▶ Unselect by scrolling over the ZCTA in the box and click the red X
- ▶ Selected ZCTAs will become shaded in black




