

Reporting “Donations” on the UDS

The following table can be used as a guide to properly reflect the various types of ‘donations’ health centers may receive throughout the year. The items listed are those commonly donated as part of natural disasters, such as those provided as hurricane relief.

Report only values of **non-cash** donations (e.g., time, supplies, and equipment) on Table 8A. In the specify field, clearly indicate what non-cash donations you received, and discounted values applied to items listed.

Report only **monetary, cash donations** on Table 9E. In the specify fields, clearly indicate the source of cash/grants received and the dollar amount.

Note: The same source may provide both cash and non-cash donations (e.g., Americares and Direct Relief may provide both supplies and money)

Volunteers and services	Table 5, on line based on role	Include FTE and patient and visit activity, if applicable
	Table 8A, line 18	Report the value of individual who donated time and service for the work provided based on salary for an equivalent if hired as staff
Medications (e.g., vaccines, pharmaceuticals, ADAP)	Table 8A, line 18	Report based on 340b drug pricing or a discounted price off the average wholesale price
	Table 9D, by payer	Include dispensing fee charged to patients or third party payers, if any
Materials and Supplies (e.g., medical supplies, hygiene and meal kits, generators)	Table 8A, line 18	Report based on discounted market price of the type of supplies and materials
Facilities	Table 8A, line 18	Report based on equivalent rental amount or depreciation value
Monetary donations	Table 9E, based on type of entity you received the cash from	See below for some specific, common examples
CARE funds	Table 9E, line 1k	Report Capital Assistance for Hurricane Response and Recovery Effort (CARE) funds awarded in 2018 by HRSA as part of Hurricane’s Harvey, Irma, and Maria relief efforts
Monetary, cash donations from foundations or private organizations	Table 9E, line 8	Report cash donations or grants from foundations, private organizations (e.g. Direct Relief, Americares, PCAs), other health centers
Monetary, cash donations from individuals	Table 9E, line 10	Report amounts from persons/individuals (not entities) who donated cash
