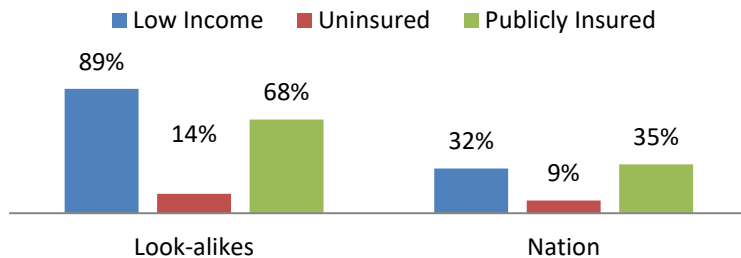
Health Center Program Look-Alikes: 2019 At a Glance

The Program

In calendar year 2019, 72 Health Center Program look-alikes provided services to 595,030 patients, with a total of 2,361,156 patient visits.

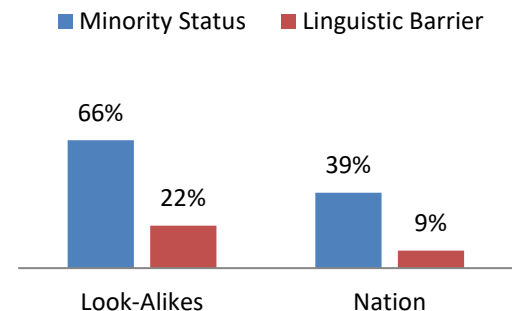
Patients: Socioeconomic Characteristics

- 89% of known incomes are at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
- 14% are uninsured
- 68% have public insurance (Medicaid, Medicare, or Other Public)



Patients: Minority Status

- 66% are of racial and/or ethnic minority
- 22% face a linguistic barrier



Services Provided

- 100% of look-alikes provide primary medical care services
- 29% of look-alikes provide dental services
- 71% of look-alikes provide behavioral health services

Continuity of Care

Look-alikes provide continuous care.

Staffing

Look-alikes employ the full time equivalent of 4,855 staff members and volunteers.

- 704 are physicians, CNMs, NPs, and PAs
- An additional 1,405 are other clinical (nurses and other medical professionals)
- 150 are dental staff
- 290 are behavioral health (mental health and substance use disorder)
- 515 are enabling
- 1,947 provide non-clinical support

Virtual Visits

- 9 of LAL grantees had virtual visits
- 0.05% of all visits were virtual
- Virtual visits were most commonly used for mental health services at 0.27%

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Quality of Care and Outcome Indicators: Clinical Performance

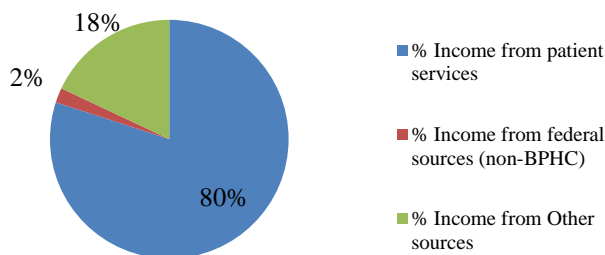
Health Center Program look-alikes provide high quality of care. Several clinical measures (asthma pharmacological therapy, controlled hypertension, and dental sealants) show performance that exceeds relevant national rates and/or Healthy People 2020 goals.

Sources of Support

Health Center Program look-alikes are funded primarily through patient services revenue.



Cost Effectiveness

- The average total cost per patient is \$1,103
- The average medical cost per medical visit is \$202
- The average charge per billable visit is \$367

Adjustments and Patient Discounts

- 41% of self-pay charges are written off as sliding discounts
- Indigent care funds cover 2% of self-pay charges
- 30% of insured charges are adjusted as allowances
